Attention Unit Owners

With transparency and an abundance of caution, we wish to inform you that yesterday we learned that a resident unit owner tested positive for COVID-19. While the infectious period for that person has passed, we realize that others in the building may be concerned about possible spread of this virus.

The Florida Department of Health encourages people to follow CDC Guidelines posted on their website, www.cdc.gov.

Please note, the CDC has updated its website to report that coronavirus does not spread easily from touching contaminated surfaces and objects then touching one's mouth, nose or eyes, although it is still possible.

According to the CDC's website, the main ways the virus has been spreading is:

- Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).
- Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.
- COVID-19 may be spread by people who are not showing symptoms.

Despite the change on its website, the CDC still encourages people to frequently clean and disinfect surfaces, maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from others and wash your hands often with soap and water. The City of Hollywood still requires wearing a facial covering when in public.
